Driving Collaboration Working Together for a Greener Future

Viridiant thrives on collaboration with a wide variety of partners - from small HVAC companies to state government agencies. Our sweet spot is bridging the gaps between the policy, the science, the dirty work in the field, and the public. We speak all of the various languages and bring our passion for delivering better buildings into every conversation.

In 2023, we continued our long partnership with the Southeast Energy Efficiency Alliance (SEEA) on US Dept. of Energy-funded efforts to improve successful enforcement of Virginia's building energy codes and to increase workforce education about advanced appliances and equipment. This work kept us in regular contact with long-time partners including the Virginia Department of Housing and Community Development, local code enforcement offices, homebuilders' associations, building trades, and technical training providers.

Viridiant's Community Energy Services division continued to expand collaboration with aligned non-profits, community groups, and local governments, particularly in the Richmond region. Examples include:

- supporting green job training focused on historically-distressed communities with Bridging the Gap;
- engaging houses of worship and their congregations on opportunities in efficiency and solar with Virginia Interfaith Power & Light;
- providing expert review of details in the City of Richmond's Sustainability Plan.

Also in 2023, Viridiant secured grants from funders including the US Energy Foundation to support our work ensuring that Virginia's deployment of federal funds would be guided by sound building science and utilize best practices to maximize efficiency gains.

Viridiant's continued work reinforces its role as a vital connector in the energy efficiency landscape, working hand-in-hand with partners across sectors to advance sustainability and education. By aligning with diverse organizations and agencies, we've been able to amplify our impact and ensure that cutting-edge building science and sustainable practices remain at the forefront of our region's future.


